Welcome to middle school at NEST+M! We are so excited to get to know you. It's going to be a fantastic year. We want to start the year on the same page (literally), so we chose a book we think you're really going to love. Please read it and come ready to discuss it on the first day of school.

Pro tip: Sometimes when you read a book in June, you forget it by September. To keep the information fresh in your mind, take notes and refresh your memory by reviewing the key details before school begins.

Book: *The Beloved World of Sonia Sotomayor*

Author: Sonia Sotomayor

Due: September 13, 2019

Activity: Write a letter to a 3rd grade student.

Please follow this format for your letter.

Paragraph 1: Introduce yourself! Tell your pen pal where you were when you read the book, share details about your summer or let them know about your favorite things to do.

Paragraph 2: Describe the scene in the book that most stood out to you and explain why you chose it. Use at least two specific details from the book.

Paragraph 3: Tell the reader what lesson you took from this book. You can make connections to your own life or other books you've read to help explain the lesson. Again, be sure to use two details from the story.

Conclusion: Wrap up with your final thoughts and two questions for your pen pal: one personal question and one about the book.

Format: If you can, please type your letter. It should be no longer than 2 pages, double spaced. If you don't have a computer at home, camp or on vacation, please write neatly and leave space for comments or revisions.
